

"Faith cometh by hearing and hearing by the word of God" (Rom. 10:17). Faith can ONLY come this way. If Genesis was vitamin A, Exodus vitamin B, Leviticus vitamin C, Numbers vitamin D, protein from John, carbohydrates from Matthew, Mark, and Luke, etc., and so on, so to speak; sixtysix complete spiritual nutrients from the text. This brings about a healthy spiritual body. Jesus said, *"Man shall not live by bread alone, but by <u>every</u> word that proceedeth out of the mouth of God." What happens in the physical world also...*

¹As with physical food, so it is with spiritual food: there are wholesome foods and there are enormous amounts of fatty and "fast," unhealthy junk food. As we feed ourselves on spiritual food, it is very important for us to consume the raw nutrients of the words of God.

²Unfortunately, Satan has taken the true nutrients of God's Word and mixed them with excessive amounts of (spiritually speaking), sugar, fat, and salt. Thus, he is creating for us an unhealthy spiritual diet. As a result, we are all not getting a wholesome amount of daily spiritual vitamins, minerals, proteins, carbohydrates, etc., so to speak, from God's Holy Word: all the nutritional elements to create, build, and sustain a very healthy spiritual body.

³Jesus said in Matthew 4:4: "Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceedeth out of the mouth of God." (Jesus linked actual food to His actual Word). There is a deeper meaning here that most of us do not catch (Deuteronomy 8; Psalm 105:37-41; John 6:28-64). There is a hidden truth here that can only be spiritually discerned if reading (or listening) through the Bible is done frequently. (Modern versions did not want us to know this secret, so they omitted, "but by every word of God" in Luke 4:4: the second of "two or more witnesses" needed to validate this crucial point). Therefore, we all must feed on "EVERY WORD!"

⁴We get vitamin A from <u>EVERY</u> word in Genesis, vitamin B from all the words in Exodus, vitamin C from Leviticus, vitamin D from Numbers, proteins from John, carbohydrates from Matthew, Mark, Luke, etc., and so on, so to speak.

⁵Imagine then if you did not read, let's say, the Book of Nahum, you would lack an essential piece of spiritual nutrition that helps to sustain a totally healthy spiritual body. Jesus is the Word according to John 1:1, 14. If He is the Word (or the bread of life), then we ought to feed on Him for spiritual growth and development. (This we see and can understand what He meant in John 6:32-58). If this spiritual nutrient continues to be lacking in your spiritual diet, over time your spiritual body will eventually suffer and break down. You may ask, 'How is this possible?' Jesus said in John 6:63, "...the words that I speak unto you, they are spirit, and they are life." John 1:1 says the Word was (and is) God.

⁶Therefore, **EVERY WORD** of God is important to create, build, and maintain a healthy spiritual body with all the benefits that go along with it. For example, a spiritually healthy body transforms the mind. It has the gift of discernment and the power to love unconditionally. It is mighty in faith (in Romans 10:17, *"Faith cometh by hearing and hearing by the word of God;"* <u>Faith can ONLY come this</u> <u>way</u>). It has the power to heal and receive healing. It gets prayers answered (John 15:7 says: *"If ye abide in me, and <u>my words</u> abide in you, ye shall ask what ye will, and it shall be done unto you"*). It is strong in wisdom, knowledge, and understanding, etc.

⁷You may say that many of the books of the Bible (particularly the books of the Old Testament) are very boring and cannot be understood; hence, you skip and avoid them. The solution to this problem is: **do not skip it! "Just read it!"** Do not be concerned with how boring it is or not understanding what you read, **"JUST READ IT!"** Even though you do not understand what it says or it's boring, when you, **"just read it"** you still get all the spiritual nutrients the book offers; thus consuming **"every" word** of God. **This is very, very important!**

⁸If you bite into and chew on most vitamin tablets, how does it taste? Boringly bitter (not sweet)! For this reason, when we take vitamins, we just simply swallow them. We do not carefully study them by biting them to taste their contents. We know they will do our bodies well, so along with water, we just quickly swallow. (This writer is not suggesting that you, the reader, avoid studying the Bible to understand what you read. What is being suggested here is that, as you read, if you come across passages that are not understood, bookmark them and just keep reading. If you stop to study every difficult passage, you will never complete your Bible reading objectives. As a result, you will not get all the spiritual nutrients the entire Bible has to offer). When you have completely "<u>sixty-six</u> consumed all the biblical/spiritual nutrients" (the 66 books of the Bible), return to your bookmarks and then carefully study them.

⁹As you take vitamins daily to stay physically healthy, you also need to take biblical vitamins daily to stay spiritually healthy.

As vitamins and minerals work in the physical realm, the same is true and works in the spiritual realm. This is why Jesus said what He did in **Matthew 4:4**, which was validated in **Luke 4:4**.

¹⁰A good rule is to read through the Bible in the mornings and return to bookmarks in the evenings, or when the entire Bible has been read, return and carefully study all of your bookmarks.

¹¹Create this habit to be continued every year for the rest of your life. For those readers who are just starting out reading through the Bible, this may be difficult to do. However, as you go through the Bible each year, as this writer does, you will find that it gets easier and easier to read, to the point where reading the entire Bible can be done in less than three months. You will then have plenty of time to carefully study bookmarks.

¹²Remember, God's Word is a spiritual book (a living book). It is alive! You may not understand the passage now, but in the process of time, the Holy Spirit will ensure that the connections and comprehension **will** come.

AGAIN! Remember and don't forget! FAITH, "mountain-moving faith," CAN <u>ONLY</u> COME THIS WAY: by <u>hearing</u> or <u>reading</u> <u>ALL</u> of God's Word! (Romans 10:17).

¹³Spiritual gifts "fully" come to a healthy spiritual body. Maybe, perhaps, this is probably why, many times, our prayers are not answered. It may be because we are spiritually weak and spiritually malnourished. Our faith is much smaller than a mustard seed.

¹⁴We must be careful with the words of God as opposed to reading or listening to the words of men. Men try to increase the hearers' faith with the words of men, hence decreasing their faith in the words of God.

¹⁵The Bible says, "Behold, the days come, saith the Lord God, that I will send a famine in the land, not a famine of bread, nor a thirst for water, but of hearing the words of the LORD" (Amos 8:11). These days are <u>NOW!</u> The Bible also says, "Take heed that no man deceive you" (Matthew 24:4); "He that rejecteth me, and receiveth not my words, hath one that Page 2 | Secret to building powerful faith judgeth him: the word that I have spoken, the same shall judge him in the last day" (John 12:48); "...the words that I speak unto you, <u>they are spirit</u>, and they are <u>life</u>" (John 6:63). They are alive; they are living!

¹⁶For your spiritual body to always remain healthy by building powerful faith, make up your mind to read the Bible entirely, from Genesis to Revelation, at least ONCE a year, for the rest of your life. **Also, this writer** "<u>strongly</u>" recommends using the King James Version of the Bible <u>ONLY</u> when doing this (not the NKJV). This is because the messages (God's Word) somewhat partly remain in (or are scattered throughout) most of <u>today's</u> modern versions, <u>but</u>, the Spirit is gone in them.

¹⁷Like Jesus Christ, who was the Word, who was God (John 1:1, 14), embodied with flesh and was the only physical representation of God (who we could have once touch, feel, handle, hold, and speak to) is also with us today embodied with words that are placed on the pages of a physical book that we can touch, feel, handle, hold, and read from. You may ask: How is this possible? Only God knows because, with Him, ALL THINGS ARE POSSIBLE with the Written, Spoken, and Living Word **oneness**. If you, the reader, can fully grasp and understand what this means, then Matthew 8:10 and verse 13 are for you, including Matthew 9:22, 28-29, 15:28, 17:20, and 21:21-22. There is a Spirit behind or in the surface text. There is a mysterious power source behind or in the actual words! When you hear or read the Word, internalize and speak it, because the Word was (and is) God, you speak GOD!

¹⁸Warning! Keep in mind that if Satan can counterfeit most godly things, then he certainly can somehow counterfeit a spirit (an evil spirit) "embodying" or <u>channeling through</u> the actual words of counterfeit Bibles or books. Thus, spiritual blindness will occur as long as these reading materials are being mentally consumed. We see this manifested in many of the well-known religious organization groups that are among us. As mentioned earlier, which is extremely important (if you did not get it earlier, it will be repeated here): The message may be partly there, in today's modern versions, scattered throughout entire books, but the Spirit is gone from them.

¹⁹For beginners, read or <u>carefully listen</u> (on CD, DVD, or online audio) to the Book of Matthew through to Revelation. Then read from Genesis through to Revelation. Use this method as your daily devotional, not other (non-Bible) books.

How does this writer know the above?

²⁰The information was born from a passion for reading the King James Version Bible (KJV) through every year to consume its contents as if they were taking daily vitamins, and eventually reading it through from Genesis to Revelation in less than **66 days each year**. That is, consuming the **66 biblical spiritual nutrients yearly**. (Not to sound as being boastful, but just only excited, on the day of this writing, this scribbler has read the entire Bible through about 37 to almost 40 times).

²¹In addition to reading, it was also born from a **spiritual experiment** done by simply putting the King James Version on an **iPod** (now built into smartphones), attaching it to an amplifier, and then broadcasting it throughout the home using ceiling speakers in each room. It was played very softly in the background that did not interfere with active conversations.

²²When Genesis to Revelation was completed (3-1/2 days), the iPod automatically started all over again from Genesis to Revelation. This went on for years. The only time anyone could barely hear it was when all the noises were shut down. Then, and only then, it was barely heard, very soft in the background.

²³Our brain picks up all noises made even when they are faint. Demons, unclean, or evil **spirits**, cannot stomach this procedure. They pick up all noises: **loud and clear!** This technique destroys their power of intent. (It is better than any alarm system). The Word is Spirit, and the Word is life (John 6:52). There is a Spirit behind the text, beyond the surface text of the Word. (Like it was when the Ark of God was taken by the Philistines, who placed it inside the house of Dagon, their god, and set it up next to it. What then happened? Read 1 Samuel 4:11-22 and 5:1-12 for the answer). <u>That Spirit is alive and powerful! That Spirit is GOD!</u> (John 1:1). To fight an evil spirit, you must fight with God's Spirit: the Word, because it is Spirit. You cannot fight a spirit with the physical; you must fight a spirit with a spirit: The Spirit!

²⁴The Bible has many secrets; secrets hidden on and beneath the surface text that will only release its knowledge if God allows it when reading. Hence, unlocking bits and pieces of "puzzles" that build an entire picture of everything past, present, and things future. To release these puzzle pieces of knowledge, one would have to continue reading or listening to God's Word in its entirety: Genesis to Revelation, repeatedly until puzzle pieces began fitting together, creating a single picture. This is like taking daily spiritual vitamins.

²⁵All scriptures above are taken from the **King James Version Bible** (KJV). If you wish to try the experiment above, use the King James Bible ONLY to do it. If you have never read the Bible from cover to cover (Genesis to Revelation) and wish to do so, use the chart below as you begin your reading and **faithfilled** journey. If you wish to start NOW (time being already far into the year), read the notes at the end of the chart.

CONCLUSION

²⁶In conclusion, for all new births (John 3:3-8, II Corinthians 5:17), God's Holy Spirit takes up permanent residence in the bornagain believer's body (John 14:16). Now, even though the uncontrolled "guest-of-doubt" unwelcome and shows up to destroy and confuse the believer's faith (Mark 9:24), when the Spirit of God's Word (John 15:7; every Word in the Bible: Jesus Christ), along with the permanently residing Holy Spirit, come together with the believer's spirit, then asking welcoming the Holy Father's or (Spirit) presence in the mix, (John 16:23-24) 14:23. 15:7. 16. supernatural things happen!

A promise to you from GOD:

To all ye inhabitants of the world, and dwellers on the earth.

If I "<u>commanded</u>" words to a thousand generations (Deuteronomy 7:9; 1 Chronicles 16:15; Psalm. 105:8), do you think those words will get lost or go missing? Haven't I then promised to preserve My Word throughout the generations and forever? (Psalm 12:6-7). Is this too hard for Me to do? (Jeremiah 32:17, 27). Can you prove I didn't? If I didn't, then you have a case against Me in the courtroom of "**My**" Holy presence (Job 23:3-7; Isaiah 45:11; Micah 6:3). This will surely "**never!**" happen because I GOD, I Am, the Word! (Exodus 3:14; John 1:1, 8:58, 12:48; Rev. 19:13).

If My Word or any part of it can get lost or go missing, then I too can

also get lost or go missing. Do you believe scholars who say "this" and "that" are lost or missing from My Word, or do you believe Me? (Ps. 56:5). Choose between the two: your scholars or Me, the Word! Haven't I spoken and it was done? Haven't I commanded and it **stood fast**? (Ps. 33:9, 148:2-5; Is. 14:24, 46:10-11). Investigate Me! Can I or any part of Me get lost or go missing?

Scrutinize the history of My Word; **all conflicting sides,** and you will find Me! (Is. 34:16). **But take heed, lest ye despise My Word and therefore despise Me!** (Num. 15:31; Is. 5:24, 30:12-13; <u>Mark 8:38;</u> **Heb. 3:12**).

For hundreds of years, I chose Hebrew "ONLY!" to write, preserve, and carry My Word around the world, to all ye inhabitants of the world, and dwellers on the earth (1 Kings 8:41-43; 2 Chr. 6:32-33, 9:23, 20:29; Ps. 46:10; Isaiah 18:3). Afterward, I used Greek and Latin. So then, couldn't I use any language "ONLY" (or languages) to do the same? Remember that I am the Word!


Search the scriptures: When "the <u>word</u> of the LORD said" (or "the word of the LORD came unto me, saying"), that was Me, the Word, speaking. So then, read **all** of Me! **Every word!** (Matt. 4:4). **Feed on Me!** (John 6:33-58).

All your information regarding Me, the Word, came from three sources: books, teachers, and your very own personal experiences. You then, personally and by yourself, **along with influence from others**, choose which of the information you will believe and accept as truth. Remember that **I am the truth!** (Deut. 32:4; John 14:6).

Ask Me "**first**" to steer your thoughts, then carefully and cautiously **by yourself**, examine the sources I will send you, and you WILL find Me! (Deut. 30:11-14). My Word is alive (John 6:63), <u>intact</u>, and is within your reach. **Today!** Even **NOW! Search for Me!** (Deut. 4:29; Jer. 29:13).

Psalm 12:6-7, 33:11, 100:5, **119:89**, 160, **138:2; Ecc. 3:14;** Is. 40:8; Matt. 4:4, 24:35; Mark 13:31; Luke 21:33; Heb. 10:7, and 1 Peter 1:23, 25. So then, you can believe Num. 23:19; Is. 14:24, 27, and Jer. 32:17, 27. Otherwise, see Rom. 14:23; Heb. 10:38, and 11:6.
